Dear Neighbor,

Last week, we submitted our Groundwater Extraction & Treatment System (GETS) plan to WDNR for review.

In November, we shared that Tyco's clean-up of the PFAS from our Fire Technology Center (FTC) was pivoting from investigation and interim remediation to solutions to permanently remove PFAS. Based on the finding that +95% of the PFAS from the FTC is in groundwater headed to Ditch B (University Creek), we designed the GETS to intercept this groundwater before it upwells into Ditch B.

Pending WDNR review and approval, the GETS will be installed to eliminate +95% of PFAS in the groundwater plume, which is a very significant step on the path to a PFAS solution for the area.

We created the enclosed <u>fact sheet</u> with an overview of the GETS, as well as the investigation and analysis on which it is based. If you would like to see the full document we submitted, you can find it on WDNR's BRRTS database.
