Dear Ms. Boyle and Ms. Bauer:

Congratulations on your election to the Town of Peshtigo's Board of Supervisors and thank you for your willingness to serve the public.

I would appreciate the opportunity to meet with you as newly elected Supervisors at your earliest convenience to discuss our shared goal and responsibility to provide clean drinking water for the impacted residents in the Town of Peshtigo. I want to assure you that Tyco continues to stand by our commitment to design and build, at our expense, a permanent municipal waterline for Town of Peshtigo residents affected by PFAS contamination in their private wells from our Fire Technology Center.

In order to achieve this long-term water solution, substantial work has already occurred. A municipal water line has been identified by multiple parties, including the DNR, and technical consultants to Tyco, as well as the Town of Peshtigo, as the best means of providing a permanent source of clean drinking water. We continue to be willing to assist the Town in retaining the legal and technical resources necessary to move forward with selecting the best implementation option for the Town's residents and seeing it approved and constructed. And, we remain open to discuss all relevant costs associated with a waterline including operations, maintenance, and water bills.

As an update, I have also attached the letter I sent today to DNR Secretary Cole thanking him for his response to my initial letter, personal commitment to this endeavor, and strong support for finding a long-term water solution.

We look forward to all parties coming together to discuss next steps so that, under your leadership, clean water can be a reality for Town residents and not just a promise.
